## Construction commencing Bank Street Pop-up Park

As part of the Blackwattle Bay urban renewal, a temporary activation of the Bank Street Park site will give the community immediate access to public amenity, while planning progresses on the longer-term park.

#### Construction information

Construction of the Bank Street Pop-up Park will start the week commencing 14 August and be carried out by Regal Innovations on behalf of Infrastructure NSW. The construction is expected to take around 6-8 weeks, subject to fine weather conditions.

Construction is expected to occur in the following stages:

- Stage 1 Site preparation: Construction fencing will be installed to ensure the public safety during construction, ground preparation works with small earthmoving equipment will prepare the site for the court surface. This is expected to take around 2-3 weeks.
- Stage 2 Site surfacing: An asphalt surface will be laid to form the pop-up park base and is expected to take around 2-3 weeks.
- Stage 3 Park building: The sports court and surface painting will have minimal impacts on the community and will occur over 1-2 weeks. Planting and furnishings will be delivered progressively to the site.

#### What to be aware of?

Impacts during construction will be minimal and localised to the site. No noisy works such as jackhammering are expected. Should any noisy works or out-of-hours work be required, a Construction Notice will be issued via the email distribution list on our website.

Pedestrian access from Bank Street to the marina will not be affected by construction.
